## Unveiling and Dedication.

Hymn 29

During the singing of Hymn 29 I shall leave the Pulpit and go to the Chancel followed by Mrs. Murdoch and the members of the Kirk Session; then follows the Dedication Service proper.

### Opening Sentences:-

### Short Prayer.

#### Minsiter:-

We ask Mrs. Murdoch now to unveil this Memorial.

#### After the Unveiling Mrs. Murdoch says:-

In Memory of Andrew Murdoch we ask you to receive this Memorial and to dedicate it to the glory and praise of God.

#### Minister replies:-

We accept this gift as a sacred trust, and shall guard it earnestly in honour of the faithful and devoted life to whose memory it is erected.

Then follows the unveiling and dedication of

Chancel until this is done and the dedication  
Prayer offered. This done the Minister will  
intimate Hymn 223 during which Mrs. Murdoch  
returns to her pew followed by the Members of  
the Kirk Session and the Minister to the  
Pulpit where the Blessing is pronounced.
